The Working Group held its kick-off Plenary Session at the end of May. The Working Group is still in the process of finalizing its structure (including formation of subcommittees), schedule, groundrules, and representation, but has begun its joint fact-finding process. There are currently over 170 individuals representing over 70 agencies, organizations, and companies who have expressed an interest in the Working Group, and are on our list serv.

Key accomplishments to date:

- May 11—MA DPU approves Utility/DOER selection of Raab Associates as Working Group Facilitator
- May 29—Raab Associates signs contract with MA CEC on facilitation
- May 31—First Plenary Session held with over 60 in attendance(See agenda, presentations, and meeting summary on website)
- June 6-11—Raab meets with each cluster of stakeholders privately to discuss both
 process and substance issues (Utilities, State Agencies, DG-Solar, DG-CHP, DG-Wind, and
 End-Use Customer/Cities/Towns). He works with the clusters to identify 18-20
 representatives (and their alternates) who will take the lead in negotiating changes to
 the DG interconnection process and tariff.
- June 13—We will hold our 2nd full Plenary Session
